HELPFUL TIPS FOR TRAVELING TO GOBBLER'S KNOB

- There is no charge to get into Gobbler's Knob.
- Gobbler's Knob is divided into two separate viewing areas, one for families and one for adults.
- The Gate at Gobblers Knob opens at 3 a.m. Phil's Prognostication is at approximately 7:25 a.m.
- There will be refreshments and food available at the Knob.
- The Groundhog Club does not recommend bringing small children to the Knob. Animals are not permitted at the Knob.
- The Groundhog Club does not recommend bringing chairs to the Knob because the large crowd mostly stands and moves around.
- There is a handicapped-viewing area at the Knob to accommodate wheelchairs and people with disabilities.
- There is a bonfire at the Knob from approximately 3 a.m. There is no shelter available, so visitors should come prepared for the weather with hand and feet warmers, layered clothing and blankets.
- R.V. parking is available at Wal-Mart Plaza.
